


Tree Warden Report 2017

Another very quiet year overall, with some activity around Mulberry Park.

1. No formal reports have been completed for the P.C. arising from S.C.D.C. notifications of work, though there have been a couple of informal comments.
2. A little involvement with the Churchyard meadow.
3. No promotional activity through the school.
4. There has been major tree removal by Mr Hunt on the A12 and removal of a hedge is planned.
5. The branch overhanging the A12 from The Limes has still had no remedial work.
6. The Prince of Wales Oak is still a concern but the P.C. may not be capable of influencing the outcome.
7. We have completed the major pruning work within Mulberry Park and thanks to the many volunteers who helped in the tidying up. It is now too late to do the work needed on the Mulberry tree and it is intended that it will take place in the late autumn 2017 however.
8. The high winds in February brought down trees along the path to Yoxwood and at the Village Hall, which were removed by Russell Pearce and Pup Barrett.
