

Yoxford Parish Council News

For many years the Parish Council have been pressing the Highways department to cut back the verge and pathway from the village to the railway station at Darsham. The pathway is so overgrown in places it is becoming impossible to navigate and pedestrians with pushchairs and wheelchair users are being forced on to the busy A12. Highways assessed the severity of the problem and decided no remedial action is necessary at this stage. County Cllr. Richard Smith, who was present at the Parish Council's November meeting, agreed to ask Highways to review the situation again.

Members of the Parish Council will attend a public meeting in November of the Sizewell C Community Forum where EDF Energy will deliver their assessment of the feedback they received from communities and statutory stakeholders during their stage 2 public consultation. The Parish Council will discuss this update, particularly the issues affecting Yoxford, at their meeting in December.

Also at their meeting in December, the Parish Council will consider their budget for next financial year.
